

Curriculum for Spanish Immersion Program with Character-Building Focus

Program Overview:

We offer a campus where everything is taught through Spanish immersion/bilingual education. This unique program combines the principles of character building and servant leadership in collaboration with "Seed For The Kingdom" and "The Rock Enrichment Academy." Our campus provides a nurturing environment where children of all ages can learn the gospel in Spanish, expanding their understanding and skills through the "Seeds for His Kingdom" servant leadership approach.

Program Structure:

- **Location and Schedule:** *all locations include lunch and recess*
 - **Round Rock campus:** Mondays, 9:30 AM- 2:00 PM
- **Age Groups and Instruction:**
 - Ages 4-7
 - Ages 8-11
 - Ages 12 and up (or by experience level)
 - Small group instruction tailored to each age group, promoting individualized learning and attention
- **Pricing Options:**
 - \$230 per student, per each day enrolled
 - Tuition to attend both Wednesdays and Fridays is \$430 per month
 - Private lessons are available per hour at \$50/hr

Curriculum Components

1. Servant Leadership

- **Objective:** Develop a spirit of service and leadership in children, based on the example of Jesus.
- **Main Topics:**
 - Principles of Servant Leadership: Understanding empathy, compassion, and selflessness.
 - Community Service Projects: Engaging in local service initiatives to apply leadership skills.
 - Biblical Examples: Learning about servant leaders in the Bible and their impact.

2. Evangelistic Discipleship for Children

- **Objective:** Teach children the fundamentals of the gospel and how to share their faith with others.
- **Main Topics:**

- Discover the Bible in a year: its books, characters, purpose, and Christ in each one.
- Teachings of Jesus: Exploring His life, parables, and messages.
- Prayer and Bible Reading: Developing spiritual disciplines.
- Sharing the Gospel: Learning effective ways to communicate their faith to peers and family.

3. Geography

- **Objective:** Provide basic knowledge about the Earth's physical and human features.
- **Main Topics:**
 - Continents and Oceans: Identifying and understanding major geographical areas.
 - Countries and Cultures: Exploring different nations, with a focus on Spanish-speaking countries.
 - Environmental Awareness: Discussing global issues and sustainability.

4. Economics and Entrepreneurship

- **Objective:** Introduce children to the basics of economics and entrepreneurial thinking.
- **Main Topics:**
 - Economic Concepts: Understanding supply and demand, goods, and services.
 - Entrepreneurship Projects: Planning and executing small business ideas.
 - Case Studies: Learning from successful entrepreneurs.

5. Leadership

- **Objective:** Foster leadership skills and ethical decision-making.
- **Main Topics:**
 - Communication Skills: Developing effective verbal and non-verbal communication.
 - Conflict Resolution: Learning strategies for peaceful problem-solving.

- **Main Topics:**
 - Cultural Traditions: Exploring customs and festivals from different countries.
 - Art and Literature: Appreciating global artistic expressions.
 - Cultural Exchange: Engaging with peers from other cultures to enhance understanding.

Special Monthly Classes

1. Art/Illustration: A successful children's author and illustrator will join us via live-stream video to present dynamic Spanish instruction, guiding students through the artistic techniques used in published books.

2. Science STEM: During live-stream video sessions, students will engineer replicas of roads, bridges, and geological wonders, applying Spanish instruction from a civil engineer.

3. Music: Students will experience rhythms, songs, and dances specific to Spanish-speaking cultures, including hymns, catchy jingles, and the sounds of unique instruments like the güiro, cuatro, and Tambor. With a special guest, an interpreter of Venezuelan folk music, and a worshiper of the Lord.

4. Friends of Venezuela: Students will participate in a unique pen pal program, building friendships with Venezuelan students through correspondence (letters and drawings) sent monthly. This program enhances Spanish grammar skills while fostering cultural exchange.

Methodology

- 1. Full Language Immersion:** All classes and activities are conducted in Spanish to promote fluency and comprehension.
- 2. Project-Based Learning:** Hands-on projects encourage active learning and real-world application of concepts.
- 3. Integration of Christian Values:** Biblical teachings and Christian principles are woven into all curriculum aspects.
